STUDIO UPDATES

TUITION, ABSENCES, & DRESS CODE

TUITION

Tuition statements, performance team event fees and costume fees are sent via email to the email address listed as the billing contact on your dancer's account. We ask that you please take a moment to familiarize yourself with the WDA Parent Portal and review your account information periodically. The portal is a great tool for updating your contact information, selecting your payment method, **updating credit card information**, viewing your account, and making self-payments online. Costume balances are due on 2/19. Families paying by check, please be sure your child's first and last name is written legibly in the notes area of your check. NOTE: Past due accounts that have not been paid by the due date will have balances charged to the credit card on file.

ABSENCES

Please remember to keep your dancer home if they are feeling sick, with or without a fever. Should your dancer need to miss class due to illness (or schedule conflict), please be sure to log the absence online via the WDA Parent Portal:

Log into your portal \rightarrow Click the hamburger menu (three lines, top right) \rightarrow Absences & Makeups \rightarrow

Green Submit Absence button \rightarrow Choose dates and classes being missed \rightarrow Add reason in the comments.

We encourage your dancer to make up the missed class with a class that is equal or one level lower within one month. Make up classes need to be scheduled through the studio in advanced as we have many classes that are full. Please email the studio for assistance with make up classes. There are NO CREDITS FOR MISSED CLASSES.

DRESS CODE

WDA's dress code is listed on our website. The footwear listed on our website will be required for our annual recital. Please have your dancer come to class with the proper attire with hair pulled back off of their face and neck (buns are required for ballet). We suggest each dancer have a small cosmetic bag in their dance bag complete with hair pins, hair nets, elastics and hair brush. Rushing from school? Teaching and office staff will help your dancer pull their hair back appropriately if they bring the items necessary to do it. During cold weather, a fitted top may be worn for warm-up only. Finally, bra tops are not permitted for dance or acro class.

CONFIRMED DATE & SHOW INFORMATION

Although participation in WDA's annual recital is optional, we encourage students to share their love of dance at this fun event. We are EXCITED to announce that we have secured the Galvin Middle School in Wakefield MA for June 12th for WDA's 14th Annual Recital, "The Wonderful World of Disney."

We believe that most families enjoyed having the shorter, more intimate shows, like last year, that allowed us to accommodate all families. We do plan on replicating that model again. Every effort is made to minimize the number of shows a single family performs in, but it is not always possible to put all family members in one show. Therefore, please expect that if you have multiple children or if your children are in multiple classes they may be in different shows. Dress rehearsals will be during the week of June 6th after 3:30pm at the Galvin Middle School; specific dates will be sent towards the end of March with schedules soon after. Dancers may not be required to be at all dress rehearsals. Details surrounding ticket sales and recital photos will be coming soon.
